Geneva Lake Level Corporation

To All Users of Geneva Lake

Action:

Starting September 3rd, the Geneva Lake Level Corp. will begin to reduce the lake elevation by about 4-5" below the dam spillway. Currently, the lake level is approximately 0" about the spillway. The lake level will then be 4-5" lower on your pier post.

Purpose:

The dam spillway located in the City of Lake Geneva Flat Iron Park requires repairs to and coatings on the concrete.

Project Timing:

The project is scheduled to begin September 3rd, but no later than October 15th. The work is expected to take approximately 6 weeks, including 4 for concrete repair and 2 for curing. It is scheduled for the early fall due to the historically low lake levels and adequate temperature for repairs and coatings to cure. This schedule is subject to change due to weather. Construction will be completed at the latest by November 30th at which time the spillway will be reopened.

Why this Notice:

Boat lifts, launches, marinas, rail systems, underpasses at the Abbey and other various bridges, shallow mooring systems and pier cribs that could become navigational hazards will all be affected by the lower lake level. Where the use, removal, or storage of the boat is a concern, it is suggested that boats be removed from the water prior to the lake level dropping, which is planned for September 3rd, the day after Labor Day.

Other Information:

The Dam parking lot off Center Street will be used for construction staging and will be closed during the project.
